Meeting Called to Order: 1100 am

- 1. Welcome:** Commissioner Baldwin called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Approval of minutes from 12-10-25 meeting – action item:** Commissioner Anderson motioned to approve the minutes from the 12-10-25 meeting, Seconded by Commissioner Donahoo, all aye.
- 3. Discussion on joining the Idaho Fire District Commissioner Association:** The board had a zoom meeting with a board member from the Idaho Fire District Commissioners Association. The board member went over all the benefits of the association and talked about cost as well. Commissioner Donahoo motioned to join the Idaho Fire District Commissioner Association including the approval of payment for membership and payment for participation in association conferences. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson, all aye.
- 4. Approval of expenditures – action item:** All expenditures, both credit card and invoices, were approved as outlined on the Expense Ratification Form dated 1-14-26 in the amount of \$162,877.75. Motion approving expenses was made by Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Donahoo, all aye.
- 5. Election of Board Chair for 2026:** Commissioner Donahoo motioned to have Commissioner Baldwin serve as Chair of the board for 2026. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion, all aye.
- 6. Other items as approved by the Board:** Commissioner Anderson motioned to have commissioner payments done once a month. Commissioner Donahoo seconded the motion, all aye.
- 7. Thornton Well update:** Idaho state law allows selective bidding by delivering bid packets to at least three companies that have Idaho Public Works Licenses. This can be done without being published in the newspaper. The bid is then to be awarded to the lowest bidder. Bid packets have been given to three appropriate well-drilling companies and are due on January 26, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.
- 8. Meeting adjourned:** Commissioner Donahoo motioned to adjourn the meeting at 12:00 p.m. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion, all aye.
